

Closest to the Pin Regulation Change

Closest to the Pin Regulation Change:

The WWGA Board voted via email to change the Closest to the Pin regulation to the following:

All closest to the pin money will now be returned to the winners by rounding down to the nearest dollar divided among the winners. The extra monies from the rounding will be placed in the WWGA funds along with any funds not won on a par three. The rounding is done so the tournament chair and others do not have to deal with change.

Examples,

The closest to the pin money totals \$100 and all four greens are won, then the funds are divided by four and each par three winners receives \$25 for their par three won. Should the closest to the pin money total \$100 and only 3 par threes are won, then each hole winner receives \$25 and the extra \$25 goes into the WWGA funds.

The closest to pin money totals \$95 and all four greens are won, then the funds are divided by four and each hole winner receives \$23 and the extra \$3 goes into the WWGA funds.

Approved on April 6, 2017 by six board members voting in the affirmative.
