The USGA Spirit of the Game

Golf is played, for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and to abide by the Rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. This is the spirit of the game of golf.

PURPOSE:

THE ASSOCIATION WAS FORMED IN 1987 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AN OPPORTUNITY FOR TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION (DEFINED AS ASSOCIATION PLAY DAYS (APD)) THAT ENCOURAGES PLAYERS FROM A VARIETY OF HANDICAP LEVELS TO COMPETE WITH OTHERS OF THEIR OWN ABILITY.

FORMAT:

THE CONSTITUTION, BY-LAWS AND RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE ASSOCIATION, PROVIDED TO YOU BY YOUR REP, OUTLINE THE GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATION.

1. INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION - TYPICALLY THREESOMES (GROUP)

THE FIELD WILL BE DIVIDED INTO FLIGHTS BY THE HOST PRO BASED ON THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS AND HANDICAP RANGES TO ALLOW FOR AN EQUITABLE VARIANCE BETWEEN HANDICAPS (100% HANDICAP ALLOWANCE). TOTAL SCORE TIES WILL HAVE EACH PLAYER RECEIVING THE ESTABLISHED NUMBER OF POINTS.

2. TEAM EVENT - THREESOMES/FOURSOMES (GROUP)

ONE OR MORE FLIGHTS WILL BE SET BY THE HOST PRO WITH TEAMS SIMILAR IN COMBINED HANDICAP. THE WORLD HANDICAP SYSTEM R&A/USGA RULES OF HANDICAPPING, ISSUED JANUARY 2024 (WHS) RECOMMENDS REDUCING THE PLAYER'S COURSE HANDICAP TO A NUMBER LESS THAN 100% TO CREATE EQUITY FOR ALL PLAYERS IN A SPECIFIC FORMAT OF PLAY; THIS MAY BE UTILIZED BY THE HOST PRO. MEMBERS OF THE WINNING TEAMS WILL EACH EARN THE SAME NUMBER OF POINTS INCLUDING BLIND DRAWS. TIES BETWEEN TEAMS WILL HAVE EACH TEAM RECEIVING THE SAME NUMBER OF POINTS.

SEASON AWARDS :

1. INDIVIDUAL - THE OFFICIAL SCORECARD FROM EACH APD IS USED BY THE TABULATOR TEAM TO DETERMINE SEASON POINTS. AT THE END OF THE SEASON GIFT CERTIFICATES ARE AWARDED TO THOSE WHO HAVE ACCUMULATED THE MOST POINTS IN THE GROSS AND NET DIVISIONS. THE NUMBER OF AWARDS ARE DETERMINED BY THE MONETARY VALUE OF THE SEASON DUES RECEIVED FROM MEMBER-CLUBS AND MEMBERS AND SUPPLEMENTED FROM THE MDD TREASURY DISCRETIONARY FUND WHEN NEEDED. SEASON CERTIFICATES MUST BE REDEEMED BY THE DATE SHOWN OTHERWISE INVALID.

2. TEAM TROPHY - MEMBER-CLUB SEASON POINTS ARE BASED ON THE NUMBER OF GROSS AND NET POINTS EARNED DIVIDED BY THE NUMBER OF PLAYERS FOR A SCORE AT EACH APD. THE TEAM TROPHY IS AWARDED TO THE MEMBER-CLUB WITH THE HIGHEST SEASON CUMULATIVE SCORE AFTER TOTALING THE APD SCORES TOGETHER AS SHOWN:

APD DAILY PRIZES :

YOUR MAIN OBJECTIVE IS TO ACHIEVE INDIVIDUAL POINTS FOR END OF THE SEASON AWARDS; DAILY PRIZES ARE A BONUS

- FLIGHTS ARE AWARDED BOTH GROSS AND NET DAILY PRIZES BASED ON THE NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS
- IF A BLIND DRAW ON A TEAM, YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED PRIOR TO PLAY THAT YOU MUST PUTT OUT ON EVERY HOLE
- TIES ARE BROKEN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE USGA RULES OF GOLF
- YOU CAN ONLY WIN ONE DAILY PRIZE; SO SOMETIMES THERE ISN'T A DIRECT CORRELATION BETWEEN DAILY PRIZE WINNERS AND SEASON POINTS AWARDED
- ONCE THE SCORES ARE POSTED FOR EVERYONE TO SEE BY THE HOST PRO, PLEASE CHECK YOUR SCORES AND IMMEDIATELY REPORT ANY DISCREPANCY TO HIM - AFTER AWARDS OR NEXT DAY CONCERNS ARE TOO LATE
- THINK YOU'VE WON BUT HAVE TO RUN! HAVE SOMEONE CASH IN THE DAILY PRIZE CERTIFICATE FOR YOU AS THEY HAVE AN EXPIRATION DATE.

RULES OF PLAY SYNOPSIS:

MEMBERS ARE EXPECTED TO FOLLOW THE USGA SPIRIT OF THE GAME BY:

- ACTING WITH INTEGRITY - FOLLOW THE RULES, APPLY ALL PENALTIES, AND BE HONEST IN ALL ASPECTS OF PLAY
- SHOWING CONSIDERATION TO OTHERS - PLAY AT A PROMPT PACE, LOOK OUT FOR THE SAFETY OF OTHERS, AND DO NOT DISTRACT ANOTHER'S PLAY
- TAKING GOOD CARE OF THE COURSE - REPLACE DIVOTS, SMOOTH BUNKERS, REPAIR BALL-MARKS, AND DO NOT CAUSE COURSE DAMAGE.

AS WELL AS ABIDING BY THE MDD BY-LAWS:

- PLAYERS SHALL CONDUCT THEMSELVES ACCORDINGLY; ANY BREACHES WILL BE SUBJECT TO A WARNING FROM HER REP WITH CONTINUED INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR A CAUSE FOR SUSPENSION FROM PLAY BY THE RULES COMMITTEE IN ACCORDANCE WITH BY-LAW ARTICLE III, SECTION III. ***INAPPROPRIATE DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR BY A PLAYER CAUSING PACE OF PLAY DELAYS AND/OR LACK OF COURTESY TO ANOTHER PLAYER WILL NOT BE TOLERATED***
- ALWAYS FOLLOW THE USGA RULES OF GOLF AND DISTRIBUTED LOCAL/MDD RULES OF PLAY
- MAINTAIN PACE OF PLAY AND TAKE IMMEDIATE STEPS TO IMPROVE WHEN ASKED - UNDUE DELAY/SLOW PLAY WILL NOT BE TOLERATED
- ALWAYS MARK YOUR BALL ON THE GREEN ESPECIALLY IF ASKED TO DO SO BY ANOTHER MEMBER IN YOUR GROUP
- ***AVOIDING SCORE DISPUTES MAY BE AS EASY AS HAVING EACH PLAYER VOCALIZE WHAT THEY LIE WITHIN YOUR GROUP ONCE YOU REACH THE GREEN. AFTER THE HOLE IS COMPLETE ENSURE THAT EVERYONE IS IN AGREEMENT WITH THE FINAL SCORES. IF THERE IS A SCORE IN QUESTION MOVE AWAY FROM THE GREEN AS SOON AS POSSIBLE SO AS NOT TO DISRUPT PACE OF PLAY. MOST OF THE TIME FRIENDLY DISCUSSION AS TO EACH SHOT TAKEN QUICKLY RESOLVES THE ISSUE. IF NOT, THE SCORE MUST BE RESOLVED BEFORE TEEING OFF ON THE NEXT HOLE. IF ONLY ONE PLAYER IN THE GROUP QUESTIONS THE NUMBER OF STROKES AND BELIEVES THEY OBSERVED THE STROKES TAKEN AND THE QUESTIONED PLAYER DISAGREES, THE MARKER SHALL ACCEPT THE QUESTIONED PLAYER'S SCORE AS BEING ACCURATE. HOWEVER, IF TWO OR MORE GROUP PLAYERS BELIEVE THE SCORE IS DIFFERENT AND CAN POINT OUT SHOT BY SHOT THE DIFFERENCE THE PLAYER IN QUESTION IS TO ACCEPT THAT "MAJORITY RULES" AND SHALL AGREE TO THE GROUP'S ADJUSTED SCORE PER MDD BY-LAW ARTICLE XII, SECTION III***
- ***SETTLE RULE DISPUTES*** BEING MINDFUL NOT TO DISRUPT THE PACE OF PLAY BEFORE MOVING TO THE NEXT HOLE. CALL THE HOST PRO FOR IMMEDIATE HELP OR THE PLAYER IS TO PLAY TWO BALLS PER USGA RULE 20 AND FOLLOWING PLAY SEEK CLARIFICATION FROM THE HOST PRO, MAKE APPROPRIATE SCORE ADJUSTMENTS IF WARRANTED BEFORE SIGNING THE OFFICIAL SCORECARD AND FINALIZING GOLF GENIUS WHEN UTILIZED (PER BY-LAW ARTICLE XII, SECTION III)
- ALWAYS REPORT ISSUES IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING PLAY TO YOUR REP WHO WILL DISCUSS WITH THE RULES COMMITTEE PRESENT FOR APPROPRIATE ACTION BEFORE DAILY PRIZES ARE DETERMINED
- PUTT OUT
 - FOR INDIVIDUAL PLAY YOU MUST PUTT OUT ON EVERY HOLE
 - FOR THE STABLEFORD ONE TEAM PLAYER MUST PUTT OUT ON EVERY HOLE (GROSS AND NET); PLEASE PICK UP IF YOU ARE OUT OF THE HOLE (GROSS AND NET) TO SUPPORT PACE OF PLAYFAILURE SHALL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION AND BE INDICATED AS A "NO CARD" ON THE OFFICIAL SCORECARD FOR SEASON POINTS AND DAILY PRIZES
- YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACCURACY OF YOUR SCORE
- USAGE OF CELL PHONES DURING AN APD IS ONLY PERMITTED WHEN AN MEDICAL EMERGENCY ARISES, THE GROUP REQUIRES CLARIFICATION FROM THE MDD HANDBOOK/BY-LAWS, RULE/DISPUTE SUPPORT FROM THE PRO SHOP, OR THE RULES OF PLAY HAVE THE GROUP ENTERING GOLF SCORES INTO GOLF GENIUS

- BE ON TIME AND IN YOUR CART BY 8:35AM. A PENALTY MAY BE ASSESSED IF YOU ARRIVE AFTER THE FIELD HAS SHOTGUNNED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE USGA RULES OF GOLF THAT EQUATES TO THE FORMAT OF PLAY.

GOLF GENIUS (GG) AND OFFICIAL SCORECARDS FOR INDIVIDUAL APDS

IF YOUR GROUP IS TO ENTER SCORES INTO GG YOU WILL RECEIVE INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE HOST PRO BEFORE TEEING OFF. BE MINDFUL THAT IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR DAILY PRIZES AND SEASON POINTS EACH GROUP SHALL ALSO KEEP AN OFFICIAL AND BACKUP SCORECARD FOLLOWING THIS PROCEDURE:

FOLLOWING PLAY, COMPARE THE OFFICIAL SCORECARD TO THE BACKUP AND ONCE GROSS AND NET TOTAL SCORES ARE IN AGREEMENT BY BEING ATTESTED BY EVERYONE IN THE GROUP, IT IS THEN SIGNED BY ALL PLAYERS.

WHEN USING GG, A GROUP APPOINTEE THEN ENTERS THE GROUP'S SCORES HOLE BY HOLE INTO GG. A FINAL CHECK BY THE GROUP IS DONE TO ENSURE THAT THE OFFICIAL SCORECARD AND GG SCORES ARE IN AGREEMENT BEFORE THE DONE BUTTON IS SELECTED TO FINALIZE POSTING. THE OFFICIAL SCORECARD IS THEN TURNED IN TO THE SCORERS TABLE. NO CHANGES CAN BE MADE AFTER FINAL SUBMISSION.

TO SUMMARIZE EACH GROUP IS TO TURN IN ONE OFFICIAL COMPLETED SCORECARD

- ADDED UP GIVING GROSS AND NET TOTALS
- AGREED TO (ATTESTED) BY ALL PLAYERS
- SIGNED BY ALL PLAYERS IN THE GROUP

IF NOT COMPLETE IT WILL BE RETURNED TO FINALIZE; FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN THE GROUP'S DISQUALIFICATION.

SCORES FROM GOLF GENIUS WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE POSTED TO GHIN AS A COMPETITION FOR INDIVIDUAL APDS BY THE HOST PRO UNLESS YOU ARE ADVISED OTHERWISE.

FOR THE STABLEFORD, PLAYERS ARE TO POST THEIR SCORE AT GHIN WHEN THE FOLLOWING WORLD HANDICAP SYSTEM (WHS) RULE APPLIES:

- POST YOUR SCORE AT GHIN IN A TEAM EVENT AS AN AWAY IF YOU PUTTED OUT ON TEN HOLES; FINALIZING AN EIGHTEEN HOLE SCORE AS FOLLOWS:

Q: If I pick up on a hole, what score do I post? A: Use the most likely score based on the following:

- *The number of strokes already taken to reach a position on a hole, plus*
- *The number of strokes the player would most likely require to complete the hole from that position (add 1 stroke if you are no more than 5ft away from hole, 2-3 strokes for 5-20ft depending on difficulty, or 3-4 strokes for more than 20ft depending on difficulty), plus*
- *Any penalty strokes incurred during play of the hole.*

MEMBER-CLUB REP POSTING ACTION PROCEDURES:

MDD ACTION - IF PLAYERS ARE ADVISED TO ENTER THEIR OWN SCORE INTO GHIN, THE REP WILL TAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTION FOR "FAILURE TO POST":

- 1ST OFFENSE - VERBAL TRAINING
- 2ND OFFENSE - WRITTEN WARNING WITH TRAINING
- 3RD OFFENSE - ASSESSED MDD DISCIPLINARY ACTION

APD ENTRY FEE - \$ 85.00:

- THE NON-REFUNDABLE ENTRY FEE INCLUDES THE CART FEE, DAILY PRIZES, CONTINENTAL BREAKFAST, LIGHT TURN SNACKS/DRINKS AND LUNCH
- TELL YOUR REP IF YOU NEED LUNCH AS "CARRY OUT" AND YOUR DIETARY RESTRICTIONS
- CANCELLATIONS 48 HOURS IN ADVANCE (REPORTED TO THE HOST REP BY YOUR REP, NOT THE PRO SHOP) WILL WARRANT A CART FEE REFUND.

CANCELLATION EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES MAY WARRANT A FULL REFUND AFTER BEING REVIEWED ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS BY THE RULES COMMITTEE PRIOR TO THE APD.

SEASON POINTS ARE EARNED AT THE INDIVIDUAL AND TEAM LEVEL BY APD FOR END OF THE SEASON AWARDS, AND WILL BE PLAYED WHEN SCHEDULED UNLESS THE HOST MEMBER-CLUB IS CLOSED THEN BY-LAW ARTICLE XII, SECTION III APPLIES.

DUES:

INDIVIDUAL DUES ARE \$30.00 AND MEMBER-CLUB DUES ARE \$ 35.00 FOR 2026. REQUIREMENTS ARE LISTED AT BY-LAW ARTICLE III. THE 2026 MAXIMUM HANDICAP INDEX FOR EACH MEMBER-CLUB (MYEHI) EQUATES TO A 30 HANDICAP AS SHOWN BELOW. AN EXISTING MEMBER MAY CONTINUE HER MEMBERSHIP (GRANDMOTHERED) IF HER HOME COURSE HANDICAP INDEX (HCHI) RISES ABOVE HER MEMBER-CLUB'S MYEHI; BUT SHE MUST PLAY TO THE MYEHI UNTIL HER HCHI FALLS BELOW SAME.

MAXIMUM YEARLY ESTABLISHED HANDICAP INDEXES (MYEHI):
