## TUESDAY GAMES – HOW POINTS ARE AWARDED

Points are awarded throughout the season for participation, chip-ins and to the winners. At the end of the season, players whose points exceed a minimum threshold will receive cash based on their accumulated points.



## Players get points as follows:

- 1. One point for participating in the game.
  - a. SL18 and MV18 players withdrawing from the game must play at least 9 holes to receive a point. MV9 and SL9 players must play at least 7 holes to receive a point.
  - b. If you play at least 7 holes you must post a 9-hole score into GHIN. If you play at least 14 holes you must post an 18-hole score into GHIN.
- 2. One point for each chip-in. The chip-in <u>must</u> be noted on the signed scorecard.
- 3. Even if a player withdraws, or is DQ'd, or does not have a handicap to compete in the game, they will still get a participation point and chip-in point(s) as long as they played the minimum required holes stated above.
- 4. Game points are awarded for Winning/Placing within each group (MV18, MV9, SL18 or SL9).
  - a. There must be at <u>least 3 players</u> competing in the group to qualify for game points.
  - b. The Lead Coordinator will use her discretion as to whether a group is eligible for points when a player drops out after play has begun. However, a player injury or emergency that causes a player to quit will not affect the group's eligibility for game points.
  - c. If a player withdraws during a game but continues playing, your group is still eligible for points.
  - d. Points awarded for rainouts during play will be at the discretion of the Lead Coordinator.
  - e. Depending on the number of players, 25% or more of the players in each group will receive points for Winning/Placing as shown in the chart below. Unlike the Weekend Tournaments, we <u>don't</u> do "look backs" to break a tie. In case of a tie, both players get the win. For example, if 9 players played and 2 people tied for first place, there would 2 First Place Winners and no Second-Place winner and one Third Place winner because the tie for 1<sup>st</sup> place used the 2<sup>nd</sup> place award.
  - f. The <u>Tuesday Game Formats/Maximum Score/Results</u> webpage describes the game formats and how the games are scored.
- 5. One point for the lowest gross score in each group. Winning/Placing within the group as mentioned above excludes a player from also receiving the point for the lowest gross score (i.e. the next lowest gross will receive the point after players who win/place). No low gross points are awarded during scrambles.
- 6. One point for closest to the pin during scrambles.
